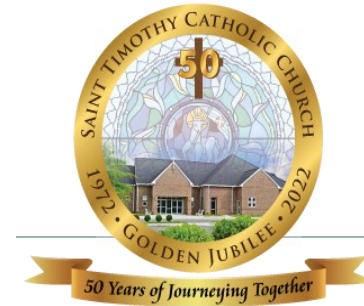

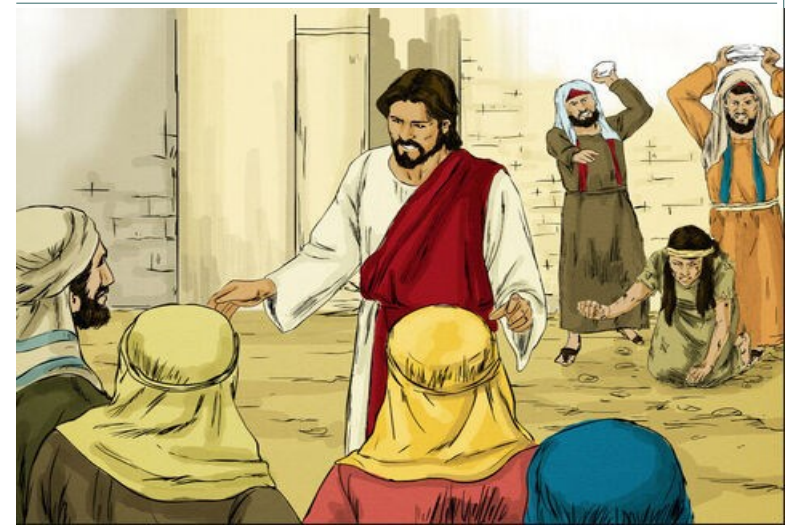

Father Mike Joly is a Roman Catholic priest ordained in 1994. He was born and raised in New England, one of a large family, and at the age of 6 he became blind due to a brain Tumor. He has served as parochial vicar in three parishes, while also spending much time in adult and youth retreat formation. He has directed a large archdiocesan retreat center and served assignments to campus ministry, including the College of William and Mary. Fr. Joly speaks fluently Spanish. 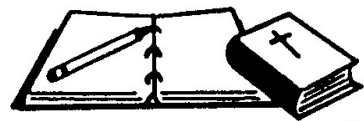

On **Tuesday, April 5**, between 11:00am -1:00pm come to the Walmart parking lot on Route 360/17 for a 20-minute consultation to help you make sure your car is adjusted properly to "fit" you. This is *not* a driving evaluation; technicians check such things as mirror adjustments to reduce blind spots, foot positioning on pedals, seat positioning/line of sight, and head restraint adjustment. An occupational therapist will be on hand to discuss adaptive devices. You'll take home some goodies and have a chance to win a door prize.
