St Timothy Lumen Christi Society Chapter



What is RCIA?

RCIA is the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, a process in which adults become full, participating members of the Catholic Church. Participants, known as catechumens, go through a process of studying the Gospel, nurturing their relationship with God, becoming familiar with the Catholic teachings and practices, professing their faith in Jesus and the Church, and receiving the sacraments of initiation: <u>Baptism</u>, <u>Communion</u>, and <u>Confirmation</u>.

Who can join? The Church extends an invitation to all who wish to become members of the Catholic faith. Whether you are someone who is of another faith and wishes to convert to Catholicism or an individual who was baptized in another Christian denomination and wishes to become a member of the Catholic faith or even someone who was baptized in the Catholic Church, but never received the sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation.

In this process of formation, candidates or catechumens go through an extended period of studying and learning about the Catholic way of life. They'll study the Scriptures and learn about the doctrines of the Church. They'll regularly attend mass and reflect on the different readings each week. Saint Augustine of Hippo eloquently described the relentless human quest for God: "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in you."

The Catholic Church believes that the meaning and purpose of life are found in Jesus Christ: "I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly" (John 10:10). Furthermore, the fullness of Christ resides in the Catholic Church: in her doctrine, sacraments, and moral teachings.

¿Qué es RICA?

RICA es el Rito de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos, un proceso en el que los adultos se convierten en miembros plenos y participantes de la Iglesia Católica. Los participantes, conocidos como catecúmenos, pasan por un proceso de estudio del Evangelio, nutrir su relación con Dios, familiarizarse con las enseñanzas y prácticas católicas, profesar su fe en Jesús y la Iglesia, y recibir los sacramentos de iniciación: Bautismo, Comunión, y Confirmación.

¿Quién puede unirse? La Iglesia extiende una invitación a todos los que deseen convertirse en miembros de la fe católica. Si usted es alguien de otra fe y desea convertirse al catolicismo o una persona que fue bautizada en otra denominación cristiana y desea convertirse en miembro de la fe católica o incluso alguien que fue bautizado en la Iglesia Católica, pero nunca recibió el sacramentos de Primera Comunión y Confirmación.

En este proceso de formación, los candidatos o catecúmenos pasan por un largo período de estudio y aprendizaje sobre el estilo de vida católico. Estudiarán las Escrituras y aprenderán acerca de las doctrinas de la Iglesia. Asistirán regularmente a misa y reflexionarán sobre las diferentes lecturas cada semana. San Agustín de Hipona describió con elocuencia la incesante búsqueda humana de Dios: "Nos has hecho para ti, oh Señor, y nuestro corazón está inquieto hasta que descanse en ti".

La Iglesia Católica cree que el significado y el propósito de la vida se encuentran en Jesucristo: "Yo vine para que tengan vida y la tengan en abundancia" (Juan 10:10). Además, la plenitud de Cristo reside en la Iglesia Católica: en su doctrina, sacramentos y enseñanzas morales.

Knights donate 280 wheel chairs to veterans and other families in need

Statewide the Knights of Columbus recently raised over \$33,000 to purchase 280 Wheelchairs for veterans and other people in need. Many were donated to veteran's hospitals and through Paralyzed

Veterans of America. Each wheelchair costs about \$150, which is about one-third of the actual cost. This is done by a partnership with American Wheelchair Mission a non-profit organization that arranges bulk shipments of the wheelchairs. In addition to the Knights order the organization donated 60 more chairs to the Knights of Columbus campaign. Saint Timothy's local Father Colin Cooke Council 10578 participated in this project.




