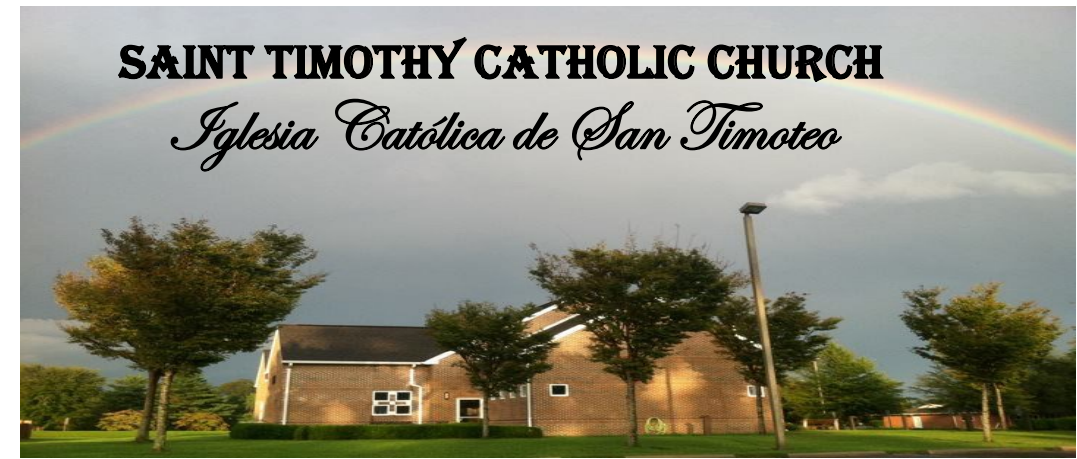

**2024 Annual Diocesan Appeal:
*Sharing His Love with Others***

I would like to provide a brief update on our 2024 Annual Diocesan Appeal effort. This year the Annual Appeal funds 22 important ministries and programs that focus on empowering the next generation, providing for those in need, and strengthening Catholic communities. The overall target for the Diocese this year is \$4,169,230, of which 22% will go towards empowering the next generation, 33% for providing for those in need, and 35% will be used to strengthen Catholic communities. Here at St. Timothy's, we've had 37 donors for a total amount collected of \$13,970. Last year we were able to raise \$18,695. If you have not yet made a commitment, it is my wish that we might raise as much or more than we did last year and exceed our goal of \$14,190!

For many of you who have not yet had the opportunity to support the Appeal, you have recently received a letter from me requesting your support of this year's effort. It is my hope that every household in our parish contributes to this year's effort. Not only are you supporting our Diocesan Community but also St. Timothy's. We receive a portion of the donations up to our goal. Anything over our goal, we receive 100%.
