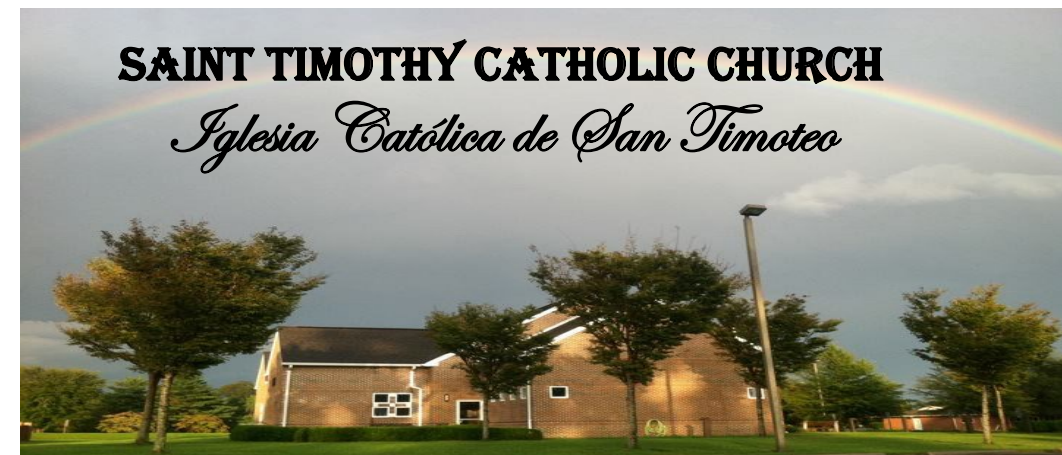

**REGISTER TO VOTE!**

Virginia Catholic Conference

This fall, voters will select candidates for the office of President, U.S. Senator, U.S. Representative and – in some areas – “down-ballot” offices. The deadline to register is **Tues., Oct. 15.**

**Who is eligible to register?**

- Must be a U.S. citizen.
- Must be a resident of Virginia.
- Must be 18 on or before the next election (e.g., 17-year-olds born on or before Nov. 5, 2006 can register today).
- Not be registered and plan to vote in another state.

**How to register:**

You can register online, by mail, or at your local registrar’s office, among other locations. Visit [vote.elections.virginia.gov](https://vote.elections.virginia.gov) or scan the QR code to:

- Register to vote online.
- Check registration status.
- Find your polling place.
- Apply to vote absentee by mail.

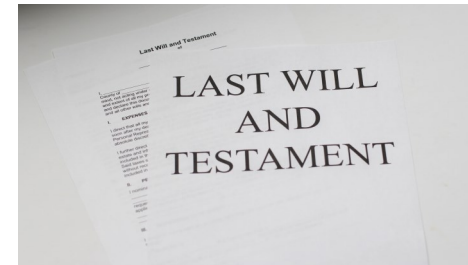
