#### Saint of the Week - St. André

St. André was born Alfred Bessette in Saint-Grégoire d'Iberville, Quebec, Canada in 1845. He was a sickly child who became an orphan at age six. He was a doorkeeper at



the Collège of Notre-Dame in Côte-des-Neiges, Quebec for 40 years. He was beatified in 1982 and canonized in 2010. St. André Bessette is the patron saint of many groups, including:

The sick, marginalized, and in need of healing: St. André's compassion and dedication to helping others earned him this role.

Family caregivers in Canada: St. André's work as a porter at the College of Notre Dame and the Oratory of St. Joseph exemplifies his service to others.

The rejected: St. André's story is an example of perseverance through obstacles.


